

**De Aston School Academy Trust Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch Up Premium Statement
September 2015**

a) The Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch Up Premium allocation for the Academy financial year:

- In 2014/15 we received £18,000

b) Catch Up Premium expenditure in the previous Academy financial Year:

- Students below L4 on entry grouped together for all lessons
- Additional adult support in all lessons
- Additional literacy and numeracy lessons (one hour per week for each) planned and led by subject specialist teachers, supported by teaching assistants
- Small group literacy and numeracy sessions for students most in need (one hour per week)
- Registration times used for Paired Reading and Precision Teaching with individuals

c) Intentions for the 2015-16 Catch Up Premium allocation (£15,000):

- Continue with grouping of students below L4 for additional literacy and numeracy sessions as outlined above
- Paired reading scheme using older students and supported by reward scheme
- Precision teaching sessions delivered by teaching assistants

d) Impact on the educational attainment, arising from expenditure of the previous Academy Financial Year's Catch Up Premium:

- English:
 - Below Level 4 on entry = 20.4%
 - Below Level 4 by end of Year 7 = 7%
- Maths:
 - Below Level 4 on entry = 16.3%
 - Below Level 4 by end of Year 7 = 6%
